Blog (Project Notebook)

- Works with dispersed workforce
- Build relationships in team
- Easy feedback from stakeholders
- Outlet for others to see
- Knowledge repository
- Doesn't mean people will read it



Instant Messaging (fast email)

- Easy conversation
- Quick status updates
- See if someone is available
- Asynchronous conversation
- Direct and fast
- But interruptive



Twitter (Push/Get Info)

- Access can be controlled (but not secure)
- Quick status updates, less interruptive
- Good for project status updates
- Live tweeting during meetings (open!)
- Meeting minutes from many
- Short messages a problem
- Overwhelming



Wiki (What I Know Is)



- Collection of web pages
- Easy to have multiple authors
- Overview with drill-down links
- Knowledge repository (permanent!)
- Can be secure
- Encourage knowledge sharing
 Takes a bit to set up (longer projects)
 Learn to manage duplicate entries





- Easy and free!
- Includes chat, audio, video, files
- Visual communication
- **Connect to stakeholders**
- Need to keep focus

Podcasts / Vodcasts / Webinars

- Get information out (easy, fun)
- Very portable
- Simple recording equipment
- Save travel costs (time/\$)
- Video files are large
- Working with RSS
- Distractions a problem



Social Networks

- Public version of blogs, etc.
- Manage contacts and connections
- Build relationships with team
- Build relationships with vendors & partners
